

PRIVACY POLICY OF THE CENTRE FOR CHRISTIAN MEDITATION

Pursuant to Article 13(1) and (2) and Article 14(1) and (2) of Regulation of the European Parliament and Council(EU) 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons in relation to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/56/EC (hereinafter: RODO) applicable from 25 May 2018, we inform you about how and for what purpose we process your personal data, ("data"), as well as your rights in relation to data protection.

1. Who is responsible for data processing and who can be contacted?

The controller of your data is the Benedictine Abbey (hereinafter referred to as the Organiser), which can be contacted:

2. What data are we talking about?

You are obliged to provide the following personal data:

- name and surname,
- city of residence,
- age,
- e-mail and mobile phone

3. Are you obliged to provide the data?

The data provided during registration are processed for the purpose of organising the meditation session.

Providing data is voluntary, but it is necessary in order to conclude and perform the "contract" with the Organiser.

4. To whom may we provide the data?

The data may be disclosed to other recipients in order to perform the agreement with you, to fulfil Organiser's legal obligation, based on your consent or for the purposes resulting from the legitimate interests of the administrator or a third party.

5. What rights do you have to ensure that your data is adequately protected?

You have the right to:

- demand access to your data, as well as demand their rectification, limitation of their rectification, restriction or erasure of your data:
- to withdraw at any time your consent to the processing of your data, in to the extent to which such consent relates, with the proviso that the withdrawal of consent shall not affect the lawfulness of processing, which was performed on the basis of consent before withdraw it;
- lodge a complaint to the supervisory authority, which is the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection, if you consider that the processing of your data violates the provisions of the RODO.

6. What are the legal bases for processing your data?

We process your data in accordance with the provisions of RODO and Polish data protection legislation.

We do this because we are fulfilling:

- contractual obligations (art.6(1)(b) RODO),
- legal obligations (Art. 6(1)(c) RODO),
- tasks in the public interest (Article 6(1)(e) of the RODO)

7. How long will your data be processed (stored)?

Your data will be processed for the period necessary to achieve the purposes of processing indicated in point 3, i.e.

- in the scope of execution of the agreement concluded with the Organiser - from the time of its completion, and after that time for the period required by law or for the realization of possible claims;
- in the scope of the processing carried out on the basis of the consent - immediately after request to delete the data;
- until the fulfilment of legally justified interests of the Organiser constituting the basis of the Organiser's legitimate interests constituting the basis for such processing or until you raise an objection against such processing, unless there are processing, unless there are legally justified grounds for further processing of data.
